Appeals Policy:

Sailing Club - Conflict of Interest:

From time to time a conflict of interest may arise. All decisions are usually decided by the Commodore or the Board of Directors. If the decision is made by the Commodore, the appeal application would be handled by the Board of Directors. If the decision was made by the Board of Directors, the Commodore would reopen the appeal with the Board of Directors for discussion and possible new decision. In both cases, the burden of proof lays with the member who brings the appeal to the council.

Sailing Club – Racing Rules:

Conflicts in racing are brought before the Racing Committee. If the conflict cannot be resolved, racing appeals can be sent to Sail Canada.

Appeals:

The appeal process in Canada is according to the rules Sail Canada Prescriptions 2021-2024 to rule 70 and Appendix R.

When a party to a hearing appeals a Racing Committee's decision, the appeal is sent to Sail Canada.
